SUBJECT: FUNDING AGREEMENT 14-03 BETWEEN THE TOWN OF LOOMIS AND THE WESTERN PLACER CONSOLIDATED TRANSPORTATION SERVICES AGENCY FOR THE PEDESTRIAN CROSSWALK AND ADA IMPROVEMENTS TO LOOMIS TRANSIT SYSTEM PROJECT

Dear Mr. Miller:

This letter, when countersigned, authorizes funding by the Western Placer Consolidated Transportation Services Agency (WPCTSA) for work to be performed by the Town of Loomis for the Pedestrian Crosswalk and ADA Improvements to Loomis Transit System Project.

1. **Funding Agreement:** This Funding Agreement is the statement of contract specific requirements applicable to the work effort to be undertaken by the Town of Loomis for the Pedestrian Crosswalk and ADA Improvements to Loomis Transit System Project. The Pedestrian Crosswalk and ADA Improvements to Loomis Transit System Project will be funded under the Public Transit Modernization Improvement Service Enhancement Account (PTMISEA) included in Proposition 1B, the Highway Safety, Traffic Reduction, Air Quality and Port Security Bond Act, approved by California voters in November 2006. The Western Placer Consolidated Transportation Services Community Transit Enhancement Project Public Transit Modernization Improvement Service Enhancement Account grant application for FY 2010/11 is incorporated by reference in this Funding Agreement.
2. **Term:** Town is to commence work immediately and shall be completed no later than December 31, 2014, according to the project schedule provided in Exhibit A: Western Placer Consolidated Transportation Services Agency PTMISEA FY 2010/11 Pedestrian Crosswalk and ADA Improvements to Loomis Transit System Project.
3. **Scope of Services:** Town will perform the tasks to manage and construct the Western Placer Consolidated Transportation Services Agency PTMISEA FY 2010/11 Pedestrian

Crosswalk and ADA Improvements to Loomis Transit System Project.as provided in Exhibit A.

- 4. **Personnel:** Town will provide its own personnel to perform the work specified in Exhibit A: Western Placer Consolidated Transportation Services Agency PTMISEA FY 2010/11 Pedestrian Crosswalk and ADA Improvements to Loomis Transit System Project. Town will also provide administrative support, management, and overhead expenses.
- 5. **Compensation:** For services rendered, the Town of Loomis will receive a sum not to exceed the amount of \$56,205 (plus any accrued interest) identified in Exhibit A: Western Placer Consolidated Transportation Services Agency PTMISEA FY 2010/11 Pedestrian Crosswalk and ADA Improvements to Loomis Transit System Project. Upon completion of the project, the Town of Loomis shall submit one invoice for reimbursement. The invoice for payment shall reference the work completed and the hours and cost associated with each task.

Pedestrian Crosswalk and ADA Improvements to Loomis Transit System Project

Construct pedestrian flashing beacon crosswalk, ADA improvements and accessories for the Bus Shelter at the Taylor Road and Shawn Way Intersection. This location does not have a way to safely cross Taylor Road to get to the Bus Stop on the west side of Taylor Road. The nearest crosswalk is at Sierra College Blvd which is almost a half mile away.

Construction Schedule:

Project Close-Out:	November 2014
Project Complete:	December 2014

Cost Estimate:

Est. New Crosswalk Flashing Beacon System	= \$45,000
Est. 2 ADA curb cut ramps @ \$3,500/ea.	= \$7,000
Accessories for Bus Shelter (Steel Bench & Trash Receptacle)	= \$2,000
Engineering Design	= <u>\$8,000</u>

Total Funding Required: \$62,000

PTMISEA Funding request: \$56,205

Remaining balance to be paid with Town of Loomis local funding.

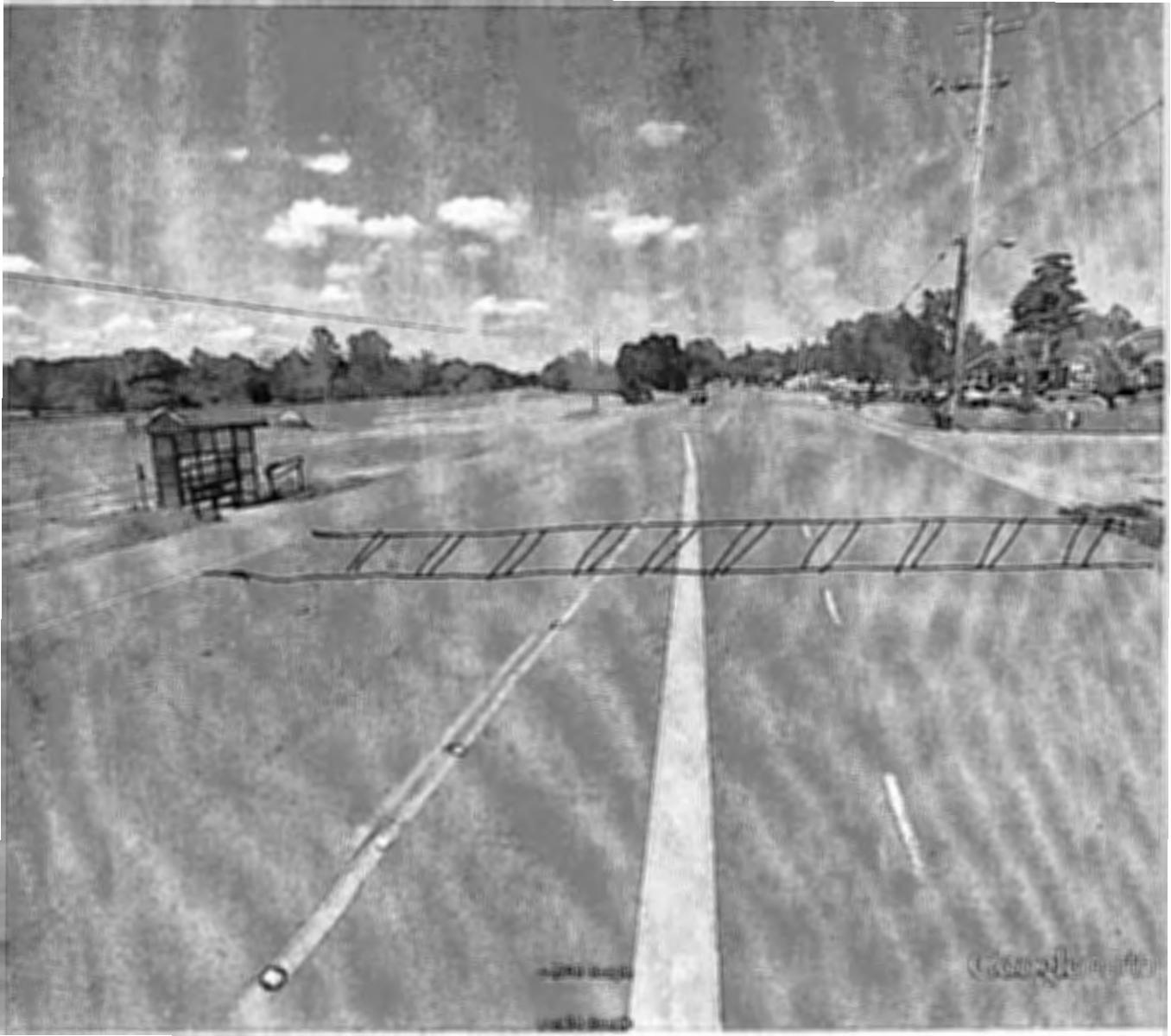
Note: At this time, several crosswalk light systems are being looked at. Loomis will install the one that best suits the location and can be installed at a reasonable cost.

TAYLOR RD / SHAWN WAY PROPOSED CROSSWALK LOCATION

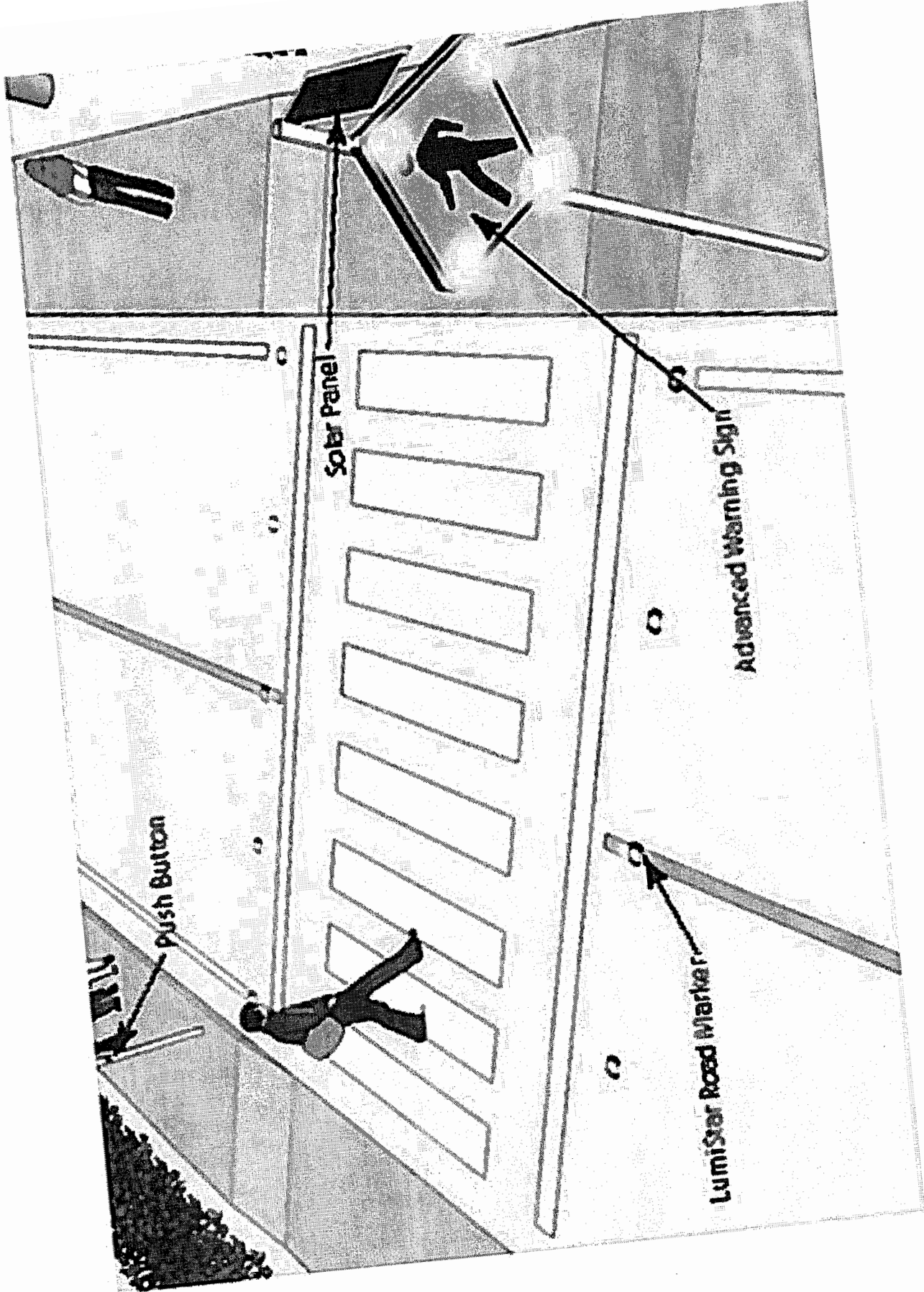

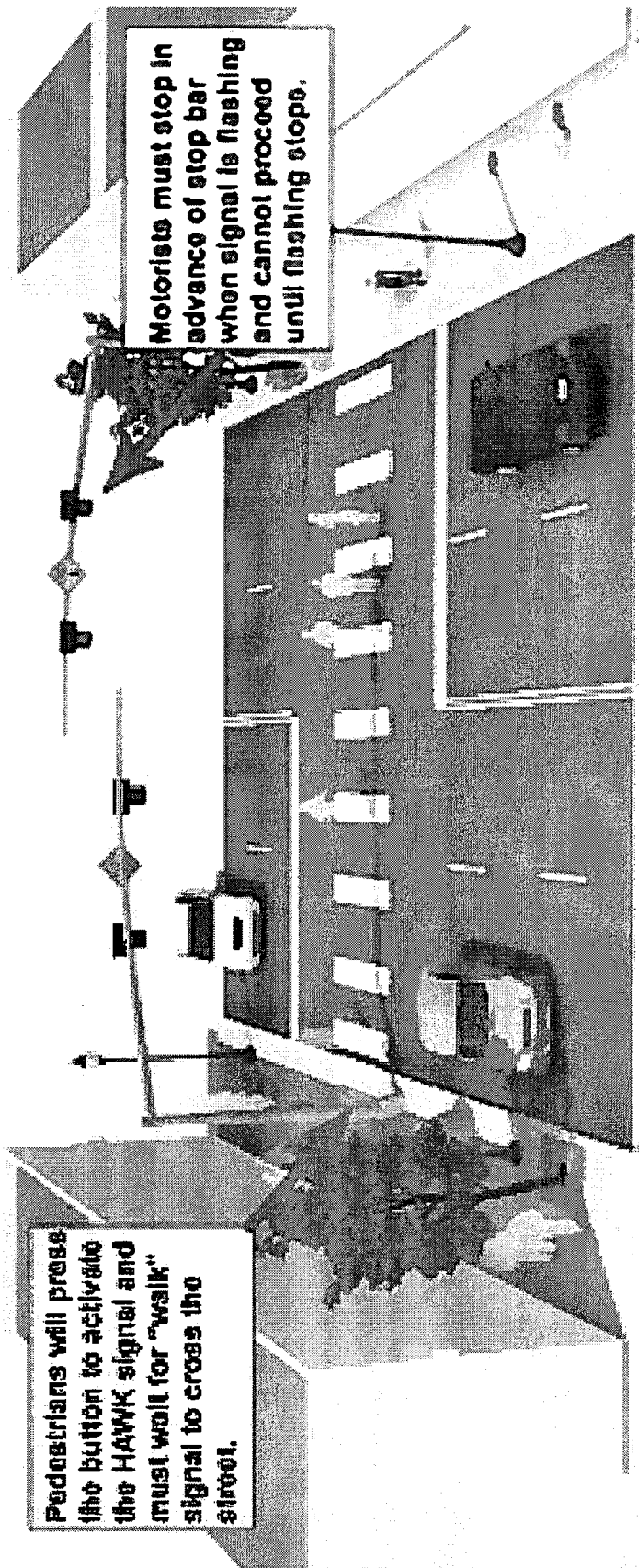

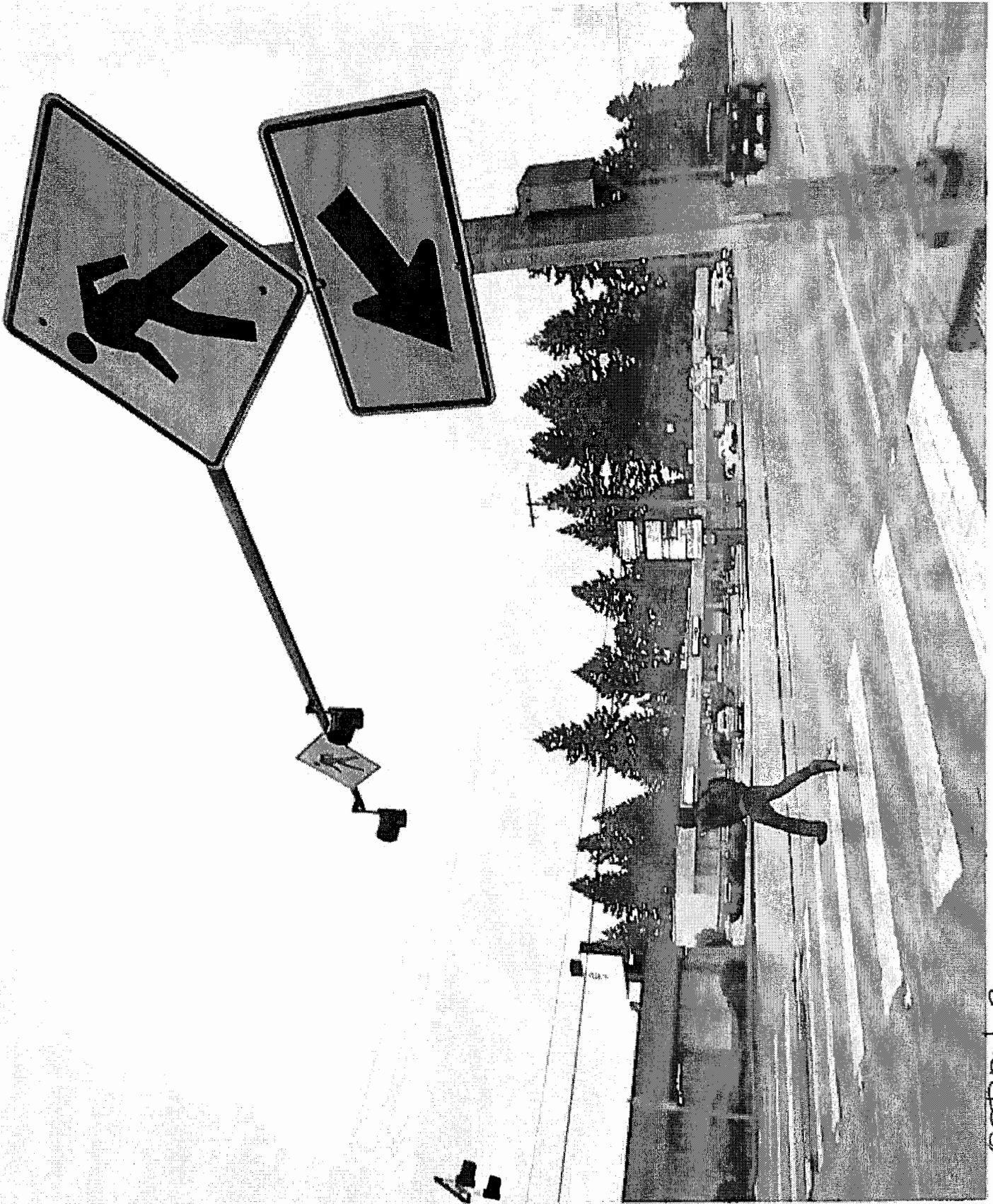
