- August 2022 Board meeting adoption
  - Funding estimate: \$16.63m
  - Funding guidelines and call for projects
  - Uncertainty with FHWA statewide corrective action
- November 2022
  - Received 18 applications totaling \$32.4m
  - Applications evaluated by PCTPA and SACOG staff
  - Delayed funding recommendations until results of ATP Grants were available in late February

- December 2022
  - Received final FY21/22 revenues
  - Received revised FY22/23 revenue estimates
- January 2023
  - Confirmation that Placer will become part of the SACOG
     6-County funding process for the next cycle
- Update the revenue estimates
